___ ___ I agree that my child may receive vision and/or hearing screenings as provided by Health Department representative or IUSD.

___ ___ I give permission to print my child's name or picture in any Orange County, Facebook, Twitter, Instagram or local publications.

___ ___ I give permission to print my child's name or picture in the OJM newsletter, Olam website or Olam/Beth Jacob marketing materials.

___ ___ I give permission to videotape my child for use at OJM or Beth Jacob Congregation.

___ ___ I give permission to include our name, address, and telephone number in the class roster. The roster will be available to families enrolled at OJM for the purposes of carpooling, mailing invitations, play dates etc.

___ ___ In the event of an accident and my child's clothes are soiled, I give the staff permission to clean my child and change my child's clothing.

___ ___ I give permission for the staff to apply a broad spectrum sunscreen with SPF 15 or higher especially during the months of March through October. The sunscreen may be applied to all exposed skin, including the face (except the eye area), tops of ears, nose, bare shoulders, arms and legs.

___ ___ In the event of an emergency I give consent for my child to be evacuated to a predetermined location as defined by the emergency disaster plan.

I understand that the preschool program staff will be doing daily health checks, required by Title 22 section 101226. Staff members are required to report any communicable disease and/or unusual marks, burns, bruises, etc. that they may observe, or any other indications of possible child abuse or neglect to the appropriate agencies per Section 1166 of the Penal code.

Regulation in Title 22, California Administration Code requires that parents are informed of the following:
Code 101200- The Department of Social Services has the authority to interview children or staff, and to inspect and audit childcare records without prior consent. The licensee shall make provisions for private interview with any child or staff member; and or examinations of all records relating to the operation of the childcare center. The Department of Social Services has the authority to observe the physical condition of a child, including conditions that could indicate abuse, neglect or inappropriate placement.
